Access to sanitary products is difficult for women and girls facing financial barriers and housing instability. Women and girls in this situation often have to decide between purchasing food and clothing or buying feminine products.

The issue is even pressing for non-profit organizations that serve this community. At D.R.E.W. Projects, Inc., we want to help relieve the cost burden for non-profits to provide feminine hygiene products to as many women and girls as possible.






Our commitment is to dedicate feminine hygiene kits to U.S. 501(c)(3) non-profits serving unhoused women and girls or low-income women and girls.

We aim to involve community members, organizations, and businesses to donate period products, such as tampons, pads, panty liners, etc., to help these organizations build up their resource closets with feminine hygiene products so that they can reallocate some of their funding towards getting women and girls services or housing.

FAQs

1 Is there a way in which you want things organized? Separated by type of product? Put everything into bags?

The products can remain in its original packaging. You do not have to separate or organize the products in a special way. However, If you would like to create smaller feminine hygiene kits, you can place a smaller quantity of each item (pads, tampons, panty liners, and wipes), into a small baggie of your design choice.

- 2 Do you take a specific brand or quantity?

 The Feminine hygiene products can be of any brand, size, or quantity. We welcome all donations.
- 3 Do you take opened boxes, packagages, or containers?

 Due to sanitary reasons, we only accept unused and unopened boxes, packages or containers of products.
- 4 Do you offer any flyers or information cards that we can use to help promote the drive?

 Yes. Our organization can provide one-pagers or flyers to that provide information about our Women's Health Initiative and donation recipient.
- 5 What do I do after collecting the donations? Do I drop off the donations or can I schedulel a pickup? After you collect the donated items, please complete the In-kind Donation form **HERE**. Someone from our office will contact you to schedule a pick up.
